WHEREAS, military members are dependent upon families that knowingly sacrifice in ways both large and small, known and unknown, to support this service in distant lands and weathered shores; and


WHEREAS, Oregon communities want to formally recognize the steady sacrifice of military families to the safety of Oregonians living everywhere our stated; and
